LETTER FROM THE CHAIRMAN AND PRESIDENT

The mission of the Jefferson Scholars Foundation is to benefit the University of Virginia by identifying, attracting, and nurturing individuals of extraordinary intellectual range and depth who possess the highest concomitant qualities of leadership, scholarship, and citizenship.

We celebrated the 45th anniversary of our founding, concluded the University's decade-long *Honor the Future* campaign, and reflected on a year of extraordinary progress across all facets of our mission. These milestones offer a natural moment to pause, not only to recognize what has been achieved, but to recommit ourselves to the work ahead.

Undergraduate Programs

In May, we welcomed the 45th class of Jefferson Scholars and the fourth class of Walentas Scholars. Next fall, for the first time, all four undergraduate classes will include students from both programs, totaling 206 Scholars on Grounds. The entering Jefferson Scholars class includes 35 recipients, while the Walentas cohort—our largest to date—includes 19 Scholars. Together, they represent 22 states and two foreign countries.

The Foundation received a record 3,035 nominations across both competitions. Of the nominees, 468 chose to enroll at UVA, comprising approximately 12 percent of the incoming class. This remarkable yield reflects the broad appeal of our selection process and recruitment efforts. In recent years, thanks to a handful of generous benefactors, we have been able to offer grants that eliminate student loan debt for a select group of outstanding finalists. Ten such grant recipients will join the Class of 2029.

Our Scholars continue to distinguish themselves as leaders. Among the graduating class were recipients of the Marshall, Truman, Goldwater, and Fulbright Scholarships. A Jefferson Scholar served as the student representative to the Board of Visitors; another chaired the University Judiciary Committee. The community also included a Mock Trial national champion, a Rotary Foundation Scholar, and the presidents of both the Raven Society and the Interfraternity Council.

That momentum will continue next year. In the fall, a Jefferson Scholar will again serve on the Board of Visitors, and another will lead the Judiciary Committee. Eight Jefferson Scholars and three Walentas Scholars will live on the Lawn, including one Walentas Scholar who was selected to live in the Augustus Silliman "Gus" Blagden III Good Guy Room. Selfless service to the University community, good moral character, genuine care and concern for fellow students, and utmost humility are requirements for that room's selection. Four Walentas Scholars completed their degrees early and will begin graduate studies this fall.

Our alumni community is equally distinguished. This spring, Maurie McInnis (JS '88) was installed as the 24th president of Yale University, the first female to hold the position. Vilas Annavarapu (JS '20) was named a Schwarzman Scholar; Jaden Evans (JS '23) was named a Knight-Hennessy Scholar. Jesse Han (JS '20) and his team at Harvard discovered the first known supermassive black hole in the Large Magellanic Cloud.

Graduate Programs

Our Graduate Fellowship Program also reached new heights this year. The Foundation supported 55 Jefferson and National Fellows, with 25 new Fellows joining in the fall. These scholars bring a dynamic intellectual presence to Grounds and pursue research that is as innovative as it is impactful.

One Fellow received the 2025 UVA Engineering Outstanding Ph.D. Student Award. Another designed a wearable navigation system to assist with underwater rescue missions. Four Fellows at Darden earned

the William Michael Shermet Award, a distinction reserved for students who excel academically while demonstrating leadership and integrity.

Among alumni, one Fellow helped the USDA reform the H-2A program, averting a crisis in America's agricultural labor force. Another now works on the BepiColombo mission to Mercury through the Swedish Institute of Space Physics. These are just two examples of how our Fellows are translating their academic pursuits into real-world solutions.

Distinguished Professorships

The Foundation's Distinguished Professorship Program continues to shape the academic landscape at UVA. In 2024–25, we welcomed four new professors, two of whom will join the faculty in the next two years, bringing the total number of Foundation-funded faculty to 14. These distinguished scholars teach and conduct research across a wide range of disciplines, including medicine, economics, engineering, law, the humanities, and the arts. Six additional searches are currently underway.

Our professors regularly are recognized for their excellence. This year, Danielle Citron was ranked the #1 legal scholar in the country, becoming the first woman to top the list. Economist Alexander MacKay received the 2025 Best Paper Award from the American Economic Association. Neuroscientist JC Cang was selected by his peers and honored with the Foundation's Award for Excellence in Teaching. Their contributions reflect the transformative potential of this program and the visionary donors who make it possible.

Looking Back-and Ahead

Much has changed since the launching of the *Honor the Future* campaign in 2015—and even more since our founding in 1980. Yet the values that guide our work remain the same: an unwavering commitment to excellence, a belief in the power of merit-based selection, and a deep respect for donor intent.

The achievements we celebrate—this year, throughout the campaign, and across our 45-year history—would not be possible without the steadfast support of our donors and friends. Because of their belief in our mission, we have exceeded every goal we set out to achieve. Notably, in 2024–25, the Foundation surpassed its \$12 million fundraising target, securing a total of \$37 million in new funds. We also outstripped our campaign goal of \$200 million, more than doubling the amount with a total of \$417 million.

This year, we welcomed four new directors to the Board: Duncan Burn, Trisha Elcan, Scott Martin, and Kristin Steen. We thank them for their leadership and look forward to the fresh perspective they bring. At the same time, we extend our deepest gratitude to Nazee Batmanghelidj, Westray Battle, Tim Naughton, and Deborah Valentine, whose terms have concluded. We also extend our gratitude to Greg McCrickard and Mike Pausic, who graciously led our Capital Campaign Advisory Committee. The service of our extraordinary volunteers will leave a lasting imprint on the Foundation. And lastly, we bid farewell to Peter Schmidt, who retired from the staff after nearly a decade of service.

To all who have supported our work—thank you. Your belief in our mission has shaped the past 45 years and will carry us forward for generations to come.

A Decade of Impact and Growth

The Jefferson Scholars Foundation's participation in the University's *Honor the Future* campaign marked a period of remarkable growth and lasting impact. Over the past 10 years, the Foundation expanded its reach across all programmatic areas—undergraduate scholarships, graduate fellowships, and faculty support—while remaining true to its long-term, endowment-based funding model.

CAMPAIGN HIGHLIGHTS

Expanding the Jefferson Scholars Program

When the campaign began in 2014–15, the Foundation's endowment dedicated to the Jefferson Scholars Program stood at \$217.5 million. Today, it totals \$384.1 million, an increase of 77%. Over the past decade, the number of Jefferson Scholars in residence grew from 124 to 149. In that time, the Foundation invested \$92 million in direct support, while stipends increased significantly: 58% for in-state students (from \$27,527 to \$43,610) and 43% for out-of-state students (\$56,713 to \$81,342).

Investing in Faculty

The Foundation strengthened its commitment to faculty excellence by securing \$144 million in support for the Distinguished Professorship Program. Since the first appointment in 2017–18, 12 professors have been named, with two more starting soon and six searches underway. To date, \$218 million has been committed to this effort, and \$9.4 million disbursed in direct faculty support. An additional \$1.4 million has supported 42 graduate students serving as Professorship Fellows.

Launching the Walentas Scholars Program

A transformative \$100 million commitment from Jane and David Walentas in 2018–19 established the Walentas Scholars Program, the premier merit-based scholarship at UVA for first-generation college-bound students. Since enrolling its first class in 2022–23, the Foundation has provided \$4 million in direct support to 41 Walentas Scholars.

Evolving the Jefferson Fellows Program

The Foundation adapted its graduate fellowship model to align with the evolving needs of the University, without compromising its commitment to excellence. Over the last 10 years, it awarded a total of \$22 million in support: \$13.4 million to students in the Graduate School of Arts & Sciences, \$7.8 million to M.B.A. students at the Darden School of Business, and \$800,000 to Ph.D. students in the School of Engineering & Applied Science.

Acquiring the National Fellows Program

In 2017–18, the Foundation assumed leadership of the National Fellows Program from the University's Miller Center. Since then, 50 Fellows have received approximately \$1.2 million in stipend support, and the program has hosted biannual conferences that bring together each cohort with top scholars and experts in the fields of politics, public policy, and foreign relations.

Introducing the Loan Replacement Grant Program

In 2022–23, the Foundation created Loan Replacement Grants to support Jefferson and Walentas Scholar finalists who were not selected to receive scholarships but qualified for federal loans. To date, the Foundation has secured nearly \$10 million in support of the grants, and \$206,000 has been awarded to 29 students.

Enhancing Scholar Enrichment

The Foundation spent \$5.6 million to enrich the Scholar experience through leadership development, international travel, professional coaching, and structured networking opportunities.

Throughout the campaign, donor support remained strong. Benefactors frequently leveraged matching funds from the University's Strategic Investment Fund (SIF) to increase their impact. In total, the Foundation secured \$417 million during the campaign, including nearly \$88 million in SIF matches—\$54 million of which is for faculty and \$33.7 million for student support.

In fiscal year 2024–25, the Foundation received \$10.1 million in new gifts and \$10.2 million in new pledges. The majority of these commitments were directed toward Jefferson Scholarships and Distinguished Professorships, with growing donor interest in gifts that allow for cross-program flexibility.

The Foundation's investment strategy continues to center on long-term sustainability. Approximately 90% of assets are invested in UVIMCO's long-term pool, which reported a 10-year annualized return of 9.2% as of June 30, 2025. The Foundation's own portfolio achieved a weighted average return of 11.2% for the fiscal year. As of June 30, the Foundation's total endowment value, including cash and investments, pledge balances, and deferred gifts, stood at \$968.4 million, representing a significant increase since the campaign's inception.

Endowment designations remain aligned with mission priorities:

- ▶ 51% for Jefferson and Walentas Scholarships
- 21% for Distinguished Professorships
- ▶ 16% for Jefferson and National Fellowships
- ▶ 12% for flexible undergraduate support and other priorities

OPERATIONAL AND CAPITAL SPENDING

A decade ago, the Foundation's operating expenses totaled \$13.8 million. By 2024–25, that figure more than doubled to \$29.6 million, reflecting growth across all areas of programming and infrastructure.

During this expansion, the Foundation maintained strict fiscal discipline, finishing fiscal year

2024–25 3% under its approved \$30.6 million budget. Of the total expenditures, 82.4% supported programs, 9.3% covered development efforts, and just 8.3% went toward administrative operations. The three-year average endowment spending rate remained a sustainable 4.1%.


Looking ahead, the 2025–26 budget is set at \$33.7 million, an increase of \$3.1 million over the previous year. Of that increase, \$2.2 million will go directly to Scholar, Fellow, and Professor support, ensuring that the Foundation's growth continues to be mission-driven. Program support is projected to comprise 83% of the total expenses.

A MODEL BUILT FOR THE LONG TERM


The Foundation's funding model has been the key to its financial success. Since inception, we have invested almost every gift received, no matter its size, and utilized the resulting investment earnings to fund our operating expenses. This conservative approach has sustained the Foundation for 45 years and ensures its ability to support future generations of Scholars, Fellows, and Professors.

With a clear focus on long-term growth, prudent investment, and responsible stewardship, the Foundation enters its next chapter well-positioned to build on the momentum of the past decade—and to advance its mission with even greater ambition in the years ahead.


FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2025

For 45 years, the Jefferson Scholars Foundation has held fast to a singular belief: that great universities are built by exceptional individuals. During the *Honor the Future* campaign, which spanned the past decade, that belief became a blueprint for growth.

Donor generosity allowed the Foundation to expand the impact of its mission: attracting and supporting outstanding students, advancing faculty excellence, and building programs that shape lives and strengthen the University of Virginia.

A Visionary Investment in First-Generation **Students**

A DEFINING MOMENT of the campaign came in 2019 with a \$100 million commitment from Jane and David Walentas (Engr'61, GSBA'64). Their transformative investment included \$50 million to launch a first-of-itskind, merit-based scholarship for first-generation college-bound students.

What began as an effort to attract outstanding students from Virginia and New York has expanded into a national program. With additional support from UVA alumni, matched by the University's Strategic Investment Fund (SIF), the Walentas Scholars Program now draws nominees from 19 regions and invites students from across the country, including Atlanta, Boston, Chicago, Los Angeles, St. Louis, and Maryland.

Next year, for the first time, 60 Walentas Scholars across four cohorts will be on Grounds. The program's inaugural class will graduate in 2026, leaving its mark on UVA through student leadership, academic achievement, and service to the broader community.

Broadening Access Through Loan Replacement Grants

THE FOUNDATION'S recruiting influence extends well beyond the holders of its scholarships. Each year, hundreds of highly qualified Jefferson and Walentas Scholar nominees choose to enroll at UVA after participating in the selection process. In 2025–26, 468 nominees will join the Class of 2029—or 12 percent of the class.

In response to the growing pipeline of top students, the Foundation launched a loan replacement initiative to support finalists who were not selected for a full scholarship but were offered federal loans as part of their aid packages. This strategic investment not only eases the financial burden for these students but also positions UVA as a destination for students who are weighing offers from peer institutions.

In the spring of 2023, the Foundation received a \$1 million challenge from an anonymous benefactor to raise \$1 million in loan replacement gifts. Four lead gifts of \$250,000 fulfilled this initiative.

Investing in Faculty Excellence

A UNIVERSITY'S STRENGTH is defined by the caliber of its faculty. During the campaign, the Foundation prioritized faculty excellence, securing \$144 million in new funding and raising its total faculty endowment to \$218 million.

In addition to its Distinguished Professorships, which are funded at the \$5 million level, the Foundation established eight University Professorships at the \$10 million level—UVA's highest honor. These cross-disciplinary appointments are designed to recruit scholars whose work defines their fields and elevates the academic distinction of the University.


